<b>7. Ratification of Dates for NDC La Salle</b>	<p>DLSU: Optimal dates 17-22 December 2016. Final exams in DLSU is from December 12-17, 2016 Other alternatives aren't optimal because they can't have the full support of DLSU in other months (e.g. October) and NDC will be irrelevant if it would be in August.</p> <p>ADDU: Are there other possible dates because other instis might not be able to attend if it would be in December?</p> <p>DLSU: DLSU would have no space for debate rooms until finals week. However, 3 letters would be secured: CHED, NYC, and President of DLSU to still ensure participation.</p>	<p><b>Motion: PDU ratifies dates of NDC La Salle (17-22 December 2016)</b></p> <p>CHARTER A: In favor: 15</p> <p>CHARTER B: In favor: 2</p> <p><b>Motion passes.</b></p>
